SAFETY BRIEFING

We've been fortunate to be injury free in the past few years. With the dramatic interest and support of rotary wing aircraft, we must be mindful of key safety issues. Key items are:

Pilots must fly aircraft from behind the safety fence.

Pilots must not taxi aircraft behind the safety fence.

The following safety violation policy voted on and adopted is:

1. 1st violation....verbal warning
2. 2nd violation...written warning
3. 3rd violation...membership revoked and prorated dues refunded
